**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH NEWTON**, County of Cumberland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the street light assessment for the year 2016.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby resolved and enacted by the Board of Township Supervisors of the Township of North Newton, County of Cumberland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

That an assessment be and the same is hereby levied on select properties served by street lighting, for the fiscal year 2016, as follows:

Properties in Oakville served by street lights	.60 cents per foot of road frontage
Properties in North Newton Hills	\$68 per lot

That any resolution, or part of resolution, conflicting with this resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this resolution.


